The ride is smooth and if you power up in the turns you are sprung straight into the next. They've a straightish sidecut giving a wider turn radius than most skis this size.

When on the cruise they feel smooth and hold an edge well giving you the confidence to carve them at high speeds. Jibbers might find them a bit stiff for the flatland freestyle, and big air specialists will struggle to get a good pop out of them.
